Known for his innovative, unpredictable live shows, Keneally has played extensively in the United States and Europe, and is now touring the Northeast US for the first time in five years. The current Mike Keneally Band – a quintet featuring drummer Joe Travers (Zappa Plays Zappa), bassist Bryan Beller (Steve Vai, Dethklok), and guitarists Rick Musallam (Ben Taylor, Byrd York) and Griff Peters (Billie Myers, Anika Paris) – will be showcasing songs from Keneally's latest album opus, *Scambot 1.
